Belmont Old Home Day is scheduled for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday August 9<sup>th</sup>. The theme for this summer's celebration is "Eras". We welcome crafts, information booths, youth groups, novelties and concessions to be a part of this fun-filled event. While not mandated, it is always fun for our vendors to play into the theme by decorating vending. For this year's event we are also encouraging our vendors to consider having activities/games to help keep the event entertaining for all ages. Consider decorating your vending space to represent your favorite era! Reserve your space now!

The 56<sup>th</sup> running of our 10-Mile Road Race will kick off the day at 7:30 am. Vendors will need to arrive by **7:00 am**. At 7:00 am Main Street will be closed for the start of the race. Vendors will line our Mill area where there will be fun filled activities to attract people of all ages. Vendors are welcome to set up tents/tables on Friday night, however this is at the vendor's own risk.

All night time vendors will set up at Bryant Park where we will have family activities ending with our NH famous Belmont Old Home Day firework display. Please be sure to **drive around the perimeter of the field** as there an irrigation system that will be damaged with the weight of vehicles. Please DO NOT park in the Bryant Field parking lot as this is reserved for handicap and emergency services. Additional parking can be found at the Middle School or Sargent Park.

The day will end with the annual Firework celebration at 9pm.

All vendors will receive a confirmation email when application is received. Parking in town is very limited. You will receive a vendor map along with any additional information by August 3<sup>rd</sup>. While we will do our best to put you in requested spots, spots are not guaranteed.
